A regular meeting of the Wayne City Council was held on Tuesday, December 6, 2016, at 8:00 p.m. in the Wayne City Hall, 3355 Wayne Road.

Mayor Rowe called the meeting to order at 8:08 p.m. and led the Council and the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

**12-16-0341** Motion by Sanders, seconded by Porter and unanimously carried, it was resolved to approve the Minutes as print of the Special Meeting of November 15, 2016 as printed.

A presentation to Angie Jarman as the 2016 Wayne Main Street Volunteer of the Year was done by the City Council.
